NCTE divided teacher education institutions of INDIA into four regions (Eastern Region, Western Region, Northern Region and Southern Region). This paper study that duration of the courses (B.Ed., M.Ed., D.El.Ed., INTEGRATED B.Sc.-B.Ed./ B.A.- B.Ed.,B.Ed. ODL MODE, INTEGRATED B.Ed.-M.Ed.), in eastern region the number and percentage of teacher education institution (B.Ed., M.Ed., D.El.Ed., Integrated B.Sc.-B.Ed./ B.A.- B.Ed., B.Ed. ODL MODE, INTEGRATED B.Ed.-M.Ed.) are present state wise, and lastly how many B.Ed., M.Ed., D.El.Ed., Integrated B.Sc.-B.Ed./ B.A.- B.Ed., B.Ed. ODL MODE, INTEGRATED B.Ed.-M.Ed. Colleges are present in West Bengal (district wise).

INTRODUCTION:

NCTE established on 1971, NCTE act comes on 1993 and NCTE becomes autonomous from 1995.Now we come to the details of the courses.

➢ B.Ed.(Bachelor of Education): This is a graduate professional course which prepares students for work as a teacher in schools, First starts in 1932 from Andhra University, Till 2014 duration of this course is 1 year in maximum universities, but after recommendation of Justice Verma Committee 2012, this course become 2 year duration.

➢ M.Ed.(Master of Education): This course also professional course. First starts in1934 from Bombay University. Till 2014 this course also duration of 1 year but from 2015 it becomes 2 years duration.

> D.El.Ed.(Diploma in Elementary Education): It is also a teacher training program done after completation of 12^{th} in any stream.

Ø Integrated B.Sc.-B.Ed. / B.A.-B.Ed.: Integrated B.Sc.-B.Ed./ B.A.-B.Ed. is a new concept. It minimises the 1 year time of student and it helps quality improvement. This course starts from 2018 season.

➢ Integrated B.Ed.-M.Ed.: This is also a new concept, total duration of B.Ed. and M.Ed. is 4(2+2) years. But in integrated B.Ed.-M.Ed. course duration is 3 years. Integrated B.Ed.-M.Ed. course saves 1 year.

> B.Ed.(ODL MODE): The name of this course is Bachelor of Education in Open and Distance learning. It is a professional distance education course. Who are not able to attain regular classes it is favourable for them.

➢ B.P.Ed. (Bachelor of Physical Education) : This is an undergraduate academic course dealing with the development and care for human body. It is also referred as B.P.E, which is an abbreviated from of the Bachelor of Physical Education degree course. It can be pursuing as a full-time course or part time course (correspondence). Physical Education course is largely suited for sports persons or those who have a passion for sports and related activities.

> M.P.Ed. (Master of Physical Education): This is a postgraduate course dealing with the development and care for human body.

2) Western Region (Chattisgarh, Gujrat, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, Dadra and Nagar Haveli and Daman and Diu).

3) Northern Region (Chandigarh, Delhi, Hariyana, Himachal Pradesh, Punjab, Rajasthan, Uttar Pradesh and Uttaranchal).

4) Southern Region (Andhra Pradesh, Karnataka, Tamil Nadu, Andaman & Nicobar Islands, Lakshadweep, Pondicherry and Kerala).

In West Bengal maximum number of colleges is present in Murshidabad (105), Birbhum (52), North 24 Parganas (52), Bardhaman (51) and Purba Medinipur (42) and minimum number of colleges is present in Cooch Bihar (7), Darjeeling (8), Purulia (12) and Jalpaiguri (14).

CONCLUSION:

So in this paper we see NCTE divided teacher education institution into four regions (Eastern, Western, Northern, Southern). West Bengal present in Eastern Region. Maximum number of teacher education institutions of Eastern Region are present in West Bengal (49.65% B.Ed. colleges, 27.3% M.Ed. colleges, 52.34% D.El.Ed. colleges, 30% Integrated B.Sc.-B.Ed./ B.A.-B.Ed.12.5% B.Ed.(ODL),51% B.P.Ed.,69.23% M.P.Ed colleges). In West Bengal maximum number of colleges is present in Murshidabad (213), Birbhum (115), Paschim Medinipur (102), Bardhaman (94) and North 24 Parganas (93). Minimum number of colleges is present in Cooch Bihar (11), Darjeeling (13), Purulia (28) and Jalpaiguri (29). Actually we are good planner, but not executer. Now teacher education institution increases day to day. We have to focus not origination of new teacher education institution; we all know increases of quantity not means increases of quality, so we have to focus not on increases of quantity of teacher education institutions but how we increase their quality.
