Registration Process:

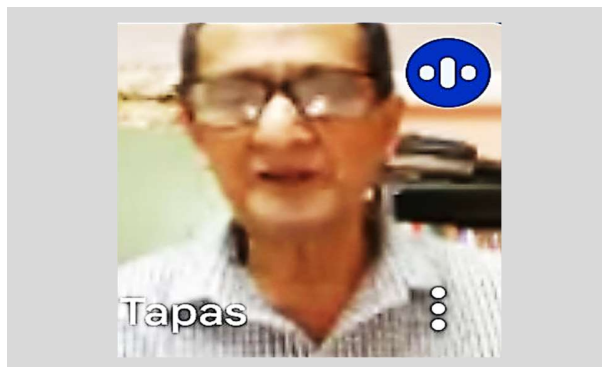


Registration for Physical Mode- The participants have registered themselves for physical mode, held at K. P. Basu Memorial Hall, Jadavpur University from 9.30 am. About 115 Faculty members, Academic Administrators from about 8 Universities and 35 Colleges, including Principals of about 16 Colleges have joined in the Physical Workshop.

Registration for Virtual Mode: About 300 candidates had registered themselves for participating in this Workshop-cum-Seminar through Virtual Mode; however, about 130+ Participants have joined virtually.

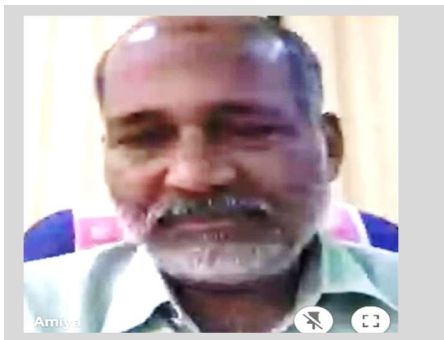

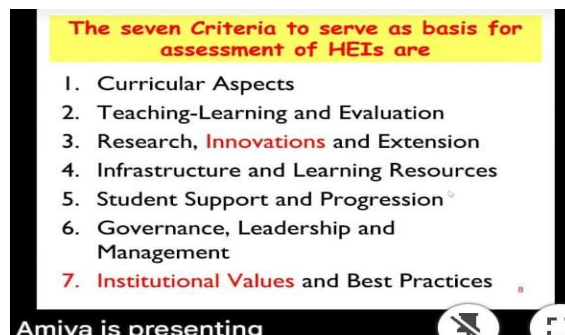
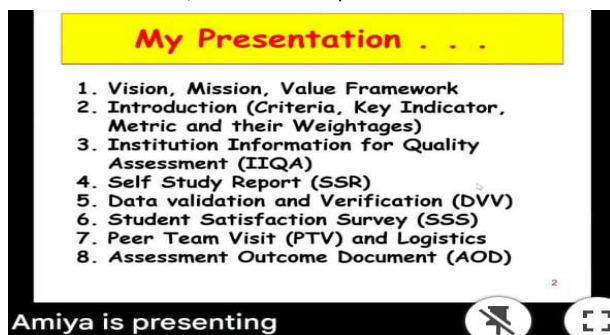
Prof. Amiya Kumar Rath, Advisor, National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC), Bangalore has delivered his illuminating speech as the **Chief-Guest** and has given the **Keynote Address** about the focal team of this Workshop-cum-Seminar virtually from Bangaluru.



Prof. Rath addresses the participants with PPT regarding the following important aspects of the updated NAAC Assessment and Accreditation Process.

- (i) **Necessity and Urgency:** Prof. Rath has categorically mentioned why each and every Higher Educational Institutions has to be Assessed and Accredited by NAAC. He has also mentioned the inclusion of some inputs of NEP 2020 in NAAC Assessment and Accreditation process.

- (ii) **Preparation and Submission of AQAR:** Dr. Rath has shown through PPT presentation that what components / documents, records have to be kept ready and what technical aspects have to be continuously maintained for preparation of AQAR by the HEIs as a team. After verification, AQAR be uploaded.



This a Team-Works of all members of an Institution, not the responsibility of the Head of the

Institution. He has also highlighted about the Old and New Formats of AQAR for different types of HEIs.

(iii) **Role of IQAC:** He has mentioned the importance and role of IQAC of the HEIs in this process.



iv) **Preparation and Submission of SSR:** Dr. Rath described about the different Criterion and the Indicators under each Criteria; which has to be dealt with very carefully and judiciously.

Question-Answer:

Participants of both physical and Virtual mode have placed several (about 30+) NAAC Process related queries to Prof. Rath through Prof. S. Dan, the Chairperson of the Session. Prof. Rath has replied and cleared the doubts of the participants; and has asked the participants that anybody can send related question online, NAAC would give reply.

Mr. Debashis Biswas, Inspector of Colleges, Calcutta University, has addressed the participants regarding updated Assessment and Accreditation Framework of NAAC. He said that the final result of the Assessment and Accreditation exercise will be an ICT based score, which is a combination of evaluation of qualitative and quantitative metrics. This will be compiled as a document comprising three parts – (i) Peer Team Report (ii) Graphical representation based on Quantitative Metrics (QnM); (iii) Institutional Grade Sheet



Dr. Samrat Bhattacharya, IQAC Coordinator, Scottish Church College said that NAAC has identified a set of seven criteria to serve as the basis of its assessment procedures. He also said that NAAC has categorized the Higher Educational Institutions mainly into three major categories (University, Autonomous College, and Affiliated/Constituent College) and assigned different weightages to these criteria under different key aspects based on the functioning and organizational focus of the three types of HEIs. However, presently HEIs have categorized in several groups.

Dr. Varbi Roy, *Associate Professor, Scottish Church College* has addressed the participants regarding Criterion-wise differential Indicators and their weightages for different types of HEIs. Dr. Bhattacharya and Dr. Roy have described about the Criterion 1 to 4 and the Indicators under the each Criteria.



Second Technical Session and Distribution of Participation Certificates:

As per announced Programme Schedule Lunch Break was from 1.30 pm to 2.20 pm, and the Second Technical Session has started at 2.30pm under the Chairmanship of Prof. Dilip Mahonta.

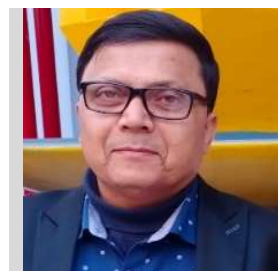

After Completion of the programme following Participation Certificates have been handed over to following persons by **Prof. Dilip Kumar Mohanta**, the Chairperson of this Session.



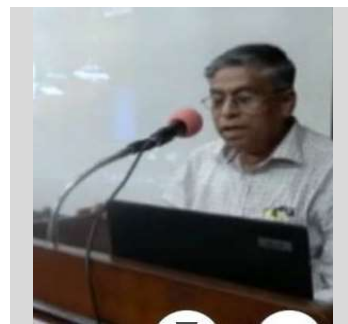
